

## **Stipendium Hungaricum**



- The Hungarian Government's most prestigious higher education scholarship programme (official website: <u>https://stipendiumhungaricum.hu/</u>)
  - launched in 2013, supervised by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade and managed by Tempus Public Foundation
  - currently over <u>90 sending countrie</u>s are involved
  - MATE offers 50 English programmes (BSc/MSc/PhD) + a <u>Hungarian Language Preparatory</u> <u>Course</u>

### Provisions covered by the scholarship:

- Tuition-free education
- Monthly stipend BSc, MSc and one-tier master's level: monthly amount of HUF 43,700 (cca EUR 110), PhD: HUF 140,000 (cca EUR 365) for the first 4 semesters & HUF 180,000 (cca EUR 470) for the last 4 semesters contribution to the living expenses in Hungary
- Accommodation contribution free dormitory place or a contribution of HUF 40,000/month to accommodation costs (in bigger cities this contribution does not cover the full amount of rental costs)
- Medical insurance health care services according to the relevant Hungarian legislation (Act LXXX of 1997, national health insurance card) and supplementary medical insurance for up to HUF 65,000 (cca 170 EUR) a year/person
- Deadline: 15 January 2024, 2 pm (CET, Budapest time)



# **Stipendium Hungaricum II.**



#### Application platform: <u>https://apply.stipendiumhungaricum.hu/</u>



#### Required documents (BSc/MSc/PhD):

- Online application form (! personal data ! fill in properly)
- Motivation letter (1 or 2?) the more specific the better
- Secondary school certificate / Bachelor degree / Master degree (MD)
- Transcript of records (! in case of ongoing studies)
- Proof of English language proficiency (B2 level) (MD)
- Passport (MD)
- PhD: research proposal, 2 recommendation letters, Statement of the Supervisor (by 15 March - 3 PhD schools!)
- Portfolio: Landscape Architecture and Garden Design, Photography
- Medical certificate (only for nominated applicants) by 15 April
- Self-financed students to SH: recommendation letter from the uni. By 15 March

#### *MD*= *missing documents (deadline: 1 August, BUT better before the entrance exam)*



### Selection:

- STEP 1 nomination (criteria differ from one country to another): complete application package is the best
- **STEP 2** entrance exam
- STEP 3 final decision by the Board of Trustees of Tempus Public Foundation (importance of priorities – 1st choice study programme matters!)
- Factors considered: ranking position on the list of nominees + result of entrance exam + quotas (country/study programme)

### Entrance exam/interview:

- **BSc level:** assessment of the uploaded documents (if necessary, oral interview)
- MSc level: credit recognition procedure (60 relevant credits) + oral interview (motivation, language skills)
- PhD level: oral interview (motivation, language skills + research topic, scientific background, publications etc.)





### **Doctoral studies:**

- 3 doctoral schools require preliminary letter of acceptance called Statement of the Supervisor.
  - Festetics Doctoral School
  - Doctoral School of Food Sciences
  - Doctoral School of Landscape Architecture and Landscape Ecology

# Hungarian Diaspora Scholarship



# Eligible applicants:

- have Hungarian roots and maintains a Hungarian identity (Motivation Letter, Statement for Application - Annex 2)
- citizens of one of the eligible countries and have an address outside of Hungary
- possess a Recommendation Letter from a Hungarian diaspora organisation or a Hungarian Diplomatic Representation
- have lived outside the territory of Hungary for at least 10 years before the submission of their application
- completed the last 4 years of their secondary education outside Hungary
- were born on or before 31 August 2006 (there is no upper age limit)

## Eligible Countries:

all countries and regions of the world EXCEPT

- the member states of the European Union,
- the Republic of Serbia, and
- the Zakarpatska Oblast region of Ukraine.

### **Provisions:**

### **Tuition-free education**

- Monthly stipend non-degree, bachelor's, master's and onetier master's level: monthly amount of HUF 43,700 (cca EUR 110) contribution to the living expenses in Hungary
- Accommodation contribution free dormitory place or a contribution of HUF 40,000/month to accommodation costs (in bigger cities this contribution does not cover the full amount of rental costs)
- Medical insurance health care services according to the relevant Hungarian legislation (Act LXXX of 1997, national health insurance card) and supplementary medical insurance for up to HUF 65,000 (cca 170 EUR) a year/person (in short intensive programmes, it is HUF 400/day)
- A one-occasion travel allowance of HUF 330,000 between 8,000 and 19,999 km upon request



#### Application Process - To successfully apply for studies at MATE complete all of the following steps:

- Letter of motivation
- Reference forms/recommendation letters from two referees
- BSc applicants: secondary school final examination
- MSc applicants: BSc degree certificate and transcripts.
- Proof of B2 level of English
- Curriculum Vitae
- Medical certificate
- Payment Confirmation of 100 EUR Registration Fee

## MATE International Scholarship Program (MISP)

## Who is eligible?

• Those who applied for SH but are not nominated (in the 1st stage of the SH application process) or not selected (in the 3rd stage)

## What are the benefits of MISP?

- MISP is to provide the last 90 credits (a little less than half the tuition fee) at BSc level and the last 60 credits (half the tuition fee) at MSc level free of charge for MISP holders. **MISP is designed to offer fee waiver at the second half of studies.**

### Application and assessment process:

- Write an e-mail to international@uni-mate.hu with the subject line Application\_MISP\_level\_program name. Applications previously submitted in DA will be promptly confirmed, formally checked and reviewed by the International Relations Centre, then forwarded to the institutions concerned.
- Call: from middle of March until middle of June 2024





- Language certificate requirements: B2 level of English is required (i.e. TOEFL min. of 500 on PBT, 61 on iBT; a 6.0 on IELTS, <u>EUROEXAM</u> or equivalent accredited language exams, including completion of previous level of studies in English e.g. GCSE or BSc) Please, note that we do not accept DUOLINGO (DET) or EF SET test as a proof of English proficiency
- Living costs 600-800 EUR/month, dormitory:120 EUR/month, cost of renting a flat in Budapest: from 250 EUR/month

- Engineering Management: <u>curriculum</u>
