

- Curriculum Vitae
- Medical certificate
- Payment Confirmation of 100 EUR Registration Fee

FAO – Hungarian Government Scholarship 2024/2025





Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations

MSc courses offered in English at MATE for the 2024–25 academic year:

- Master in Crop Production Engineering Szent István Campus, Gödöllő
- Master in Horticultural Engineering Buda Campus, Budapest

The scholarship covers:

- application and tuition fees throughout the study period with basic books and notes;
- dormitory accommodation;
- subsistence costs; currently: 90.000 HUF/month (appr.: 240 EUR)
- health insurance.

All of the above mentioned costs are financed by the Hungarian Government, according to the Agreement between FAO and Hungary in 2007.

The scholarship covers **students' costs only**; family members are not supported within the frame of this programme.



Student selection will take place in two phases:

- **Phase 1:** FAO will pre-screen candidates and submit applications to the Ministry of Agriculture of Hungary that will send them to the corresponding University as chosen by the applicants. Students must submit only COMPLETE dossiers. **Incomplete dossiers will not be considered**. Files without names will not be processed.
- **Phase 2:** Selected candidates may be asked to take a written or oral English examination as part of the admission procedure. The participating University will run a further selection process and inform each of the successful candidates. Selected students will also be notified by the Ministry.
- Candidates will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:
 - Citizenship and residency of one of the eligible countries*
 - Excellent school achievements
 - English language proficiency (for courses taught in English)
 - Motivation
 - Good health (form e.g.: <u>Medical certificate</u>)
 - Age (candidates 30 are preferred)

- > PhD: Statement of the Supervisor to be uploaded (by **15 March**)
- Self-financed students to SH: recommendation letter from the uni. by **15 March**
- Medical certificate (only for nominated applicants) by 15 April
- Portfolio is necessary: Landscape Architecture and Garden Design, Photography, Film & Media, Media Design
- > <u>Missing documents</u> (by 1 August) BETTER to upload before the entrance exam
 - Secondary school certificate / Bachelor degree / Master's degree
 - > Proof of English language proficiency (B2 level is required) see slide Q&A
 - > Passport

Stipendium Hungaricum II.



Selection process:

- STEP 1 nomination (criteria differ from one country to another): complete application package is the best (middle of Jan – end of Feb)
- **STEP 2** entrance exam (middle of March end of May)
- STEP 3 final decision (end of June) by the Board of Trustees of Tempus Public Foundation (importance of priorities: 1st choice study programme matters!)
- Factors considered: your ranking position on the list of nominees + result of entrance exam (0-100 scale) + quotas (country/study programme)
- > Entrance exam/interview (info and invitation via email):
 - BSc level: based on the assessment of the uploaded documents (if necessary, oral interview)
 - MSc level: credit recognition procedure (60 relevant credits) + oral interview (motivation, language skills)
 - PhD level: oral interview (motivation, language skills + research topic, scientific background, publications, presentations at conferences etc.)

Platform: Teams / Zoom / DreamApply recorded interview





Doctoral studies:

- At MATE, 3 doctoral schools consider the Statement of the Supervisor document compulsory to be uploaded by 15 March:
 - Festetics Doctoral School
 - Doctoral School of Food Sciences
 - Doctoral School of Landscape Architecture and Landscape Ecology

In the lack of this document, your application will be formally rejected, no entrance exam either.

MATE International Scholarship Program (MISP)

> Who is eligible?

Those who applied for SH or SCYP but are **not nominated** (in the 1st stage of the SH application process) or **not selected** (in the 3rd stage)

What are the benefits of MISP?

MISP is to provide the last 90 credits (a little less than half the tuition fee) at BSc level and the last 60 credits (half the tuition fee) at MSc level free of charge for MISP holders. MISP is designed to offer fee waiver at the second half of studies.

- 2 Calls: from middle of March and middle of June 2024

Hungarian Diaspora Scholarship



Eligible applicants:

- have Hungarian roots and maintains a Hungarian identity (Motivation Letter, Statement for Application - Annex 2)
- citizens of one of the eligible countries and have an address outside of Hungary
- possess a Recommendation Letter from a Hungarian diaspora organisation or a Hungarian Diplomatic Representation
- have lived outside the territory of Hungary for at least 10 years before the submission of their application
- completed the last 4 years of their secondary education outside Hungary
- were born on or before 31 August 2006 (there is no upper age limit)

Eligible Countries:

all countries and regions of the world EXCEPT

- the member states of the European Union,
- the Republic of Serbia, and
- the Zakarpatska Oblast region of Ukraine.





- Language certificate requirements: B2 level of English is required (i.e. TOEFL min. of 500 on PBT, 61 on iBT; a 6.0 on IELTS, <u>EUROEXAM</u> or equivalent accredited language exams), completion of previous level of studies in English is acceptable (e.g. GCSE or BSc) an official statement is required from the respective institution. Please, note that we do not accept DUOLINGO (DET) or EF SET test as a proof of English proficiency
- Portfolio (Film and Media, Media Design, Photography): Applicants can attach material in any format as part of their portfolio, be it a short film, a photo series, video, PDF summary or anything that adds value and represents the level of the artist. The point is to gain insight into his/her art.
- Accreditation: All announced programmes of MATE are accredited (also at EU level)





- Living in Hungary / costs 600-800 EUR/month, dormitory:120 EUR/month, cost of renting a flat in Budapest: from 250 EUR/month
- > Working as a student: max. 30 hours/week
- Residency after graduation
