

Founded on the 1st of February 2021, the Hungarian University of Agriculture and Life Sciences (MATE) has become one of the largest and oldest agricultural-focused, multi-disciplinary tertiary education institutions in Europe, which came into being by the integration of the former Szent István University, Kaposvár University, Gyöngyös Campus of Eszterházy Károly University and Georgikon Faculty of University of Pannonia. SZENT ISTVÁN CAMPUS

↘ Gödöllő is the central home of MATE, known for its spacious, nature-rich campus and strong research atmosphere. The town is also famous for the Royal Palace of Gödöllő, one of Hungary's most important historical sites and a symbol of royal heritage in the region. It is one of the largest university campuses in the country, where agricultural, technical and economic university programmes are offered. The train station right next to the campus allows fast travel to the heart of Budapest.



BUDA CAMPUS

↘ Budapest is Hungary's capital and its biggest international hub – full of student life, culture, and career opportunities. With its grand architecture and Danube river views, it really does feel like a place where history and modern energy live side by side. Located in Buda Arboretum, the Buda Campus offers a beautiful green refuge right in the heart of this bustling city

KAPOSVÁR CAMPUS

Kaposvár is a relaxed, student-oriented town with lots of parks, walkable streets, and a strong local cultural scene. It's known in Hungary for its tidy, green public spaces and welcoming atmosphere, making it a great place for focused study and a close-knit campus community. If you want a slower pace with real support and space to grow, Kaposvár delivers. It is where you can find all of MATE's art courses.



GEORGIKON CAMPUS

Keszthely sits on the western shore of Lake Balaton, the country's most beloved summer region and a key area for tourism, nature, and sports. Studying here means being close to nature, while living in a charming, scenic city. The predecessor of Georgikon Campus was the first agricultural tertiary institution in Hungary and Europe, and is still a prestigious symbol of Hungary's agricultural tradition.



KÁROLY RÓBERT CAMPUS

Gyöngyös lies right next to the Mátra range, home to Hungary's highest peak, and is a natural starting point for exploring the mountains. The city is perfect for students who feel inspired by forests, hiking trails, and outdoor life – quiet enough for deep focus, adventurous enough for weekends outdoors. It is a very modern, international campus, building on a strong foundation of agriculture, business and technology, both in higher and vocational education.

- Proof of English language proficiency – B2 level




