To provide you with assistance, this message is to guide you with the current rules and regulations which apply in our country regarding entering. In the long run, your educational coordinator given in your PLoA, will be at your disposal.

After the receipt of your Letter of Acceptance, you can start to arrange your visa process and the preparations for entering Hungary. To guide you regarding the process, we organised **online consultation** opportunities. To revise the content, check our website using [this link](#). Those **who are not subject to visa**, please, [register to get a group appointment](#) at the Immigration Office. Relevant information will be shared with them privately.

The academic year begins on 8th September with our [Orientation Week](#). Classes for 1st year students start on 15th September.

Please, note that self-financed students **cannot be provided accommodation in the dorm in Gödöllő and in Buda**. Places are offered in [Gyöngyös](#) (for Buda, Gödöllő and Gyöngyös students), in [Kaposvár](#) (for Kaposvár students) and in [Keszthely](#) (for Georgikon Campus students).

If there is **any change** about your planned arrival date, **you are obliged to inform the hostel you applied for within the shortest possible time. Your booked room in the dorm will not be saved for you for more than 5 days after your registered date of arrival**, since there is a huge demand for dormitory places. All students are required to fill in the [Arrival Form](#) to inform our Institution and the dormitories of the details of their arrival.

CHANGE in public transport! Between 25 Aug – 20 Sept, Keleti Railway Station will be closed. Please, plan your journey accordingly. From Gödöllő to Budapest and back suburban train (HÉV, H8) and Volánbusz Bus service (Gödöllő Bus station - Budapest Stadionok) can be an option.
