On behalf of the Management of **Hungarian University of Agriculture and Life Sciences, MATE International Relations Team** is happy to welcome you soon. To provide you with assistance, this message is to guide you with the current rules and regulations which apply in our country regarding entering.

After the receipt of your Letter of Acceptance and Letter of Award, you must have started to arrange your visa process and the preparations for entering Hungary. To guide you regarding the process, we organise an **online consultation** opportunity on **15th August at 13:00 CET**. You can join using [this link](#). Those who are not subject to visa are also advised to join. Relevant information will be shared for them, too.

The academic year begins on 9th September with our [Orientation Week](#). Classes for 1st year students start on 16th September.

Please, note that first-year emPLANT+ students can only be provided accommodation in the dorm during their 1st academic year in case they apply for accommodation via the **Hostel Application Form until August 10th**.

If there is **any change** about your planned arrival date, **you are obliged to inform the hostel within the shortest possible time. Your booked room in the dorm will not be saved for you for more than 5 days after your registered date of arrival**, since there is a huge demand for dormitory places. All students are required to fill in the [Arrival Form](#) to inform our Institution and the dormitories of the details of their arrival. Those who will study at Szent István Campus – Gödöllő are entitled to a free ride from the airport to the dormitory.
