After the receipt of your Letter of Acceptance, you can start to arrange your visa process and the preparations for entering Hungary. Those who are not subject to visa are also advised to join. Relevant information will be shared for them, too.

The academic year begins on 9<sup>th</sup> September with our [Orientation Week](#). Classes for 1<sup>st</sup> year students start on 16<sup>th</sup> September.

Please, note that 1<sup>st</sup>-year MISP scholars can only be provided accommodation in the dorm **on their own cost**. Places are offered in [Gyöngyös](#) (for Buda, Gödöllő and Gyöngyös students), in [Kaposvár](#) (for Kaposvár students) and in [Keszthely](#) (for Georgikon Campus students).

Please, apply for accommodation via the **Hostel Application Form** (linked words) **until August 10<sup>th</sup>**. If there is **any change** about your planned arrival date, **you are obliged to inform the hostel, your Registrar's Officer and your Institutional Coordinator within the shortest possible time. Your booked room in the dorm will not be saved for you for more than 5 days after your registered date of arrival**, since there is a huge demand for dormitory places. All students are required to fill in the [Arrival Form](#) to inform our Institution and the dormitories of the details of their arrival.
