Obligations of Scholarship Holders I.



Fundamental obligations to bear in mind (ORs - Section III.2-3.):



Signing SH agreement and registering in person at IRC of campus

- essential for receiving your monthly stipend (1st in October!)



Compulsory medical examination after your arrival in Hungary Tempus will provide further information on "when" to start

Take the original medical reports with you!

Reporting obligation: SURVEY to fill in at the end of each academic year (link from Tempus in June) – EMAIL address!!!

! Failing to do so, your scholarship might be suspended / eventually terminated

Obligations of Scholarship Holders II.



Obligations related to your studies:

- For full-time **BSc** and **MSc students**: to attend and complete **Hungarian as a Foreign Language and Culture (SH) I-II. = MID** (semester I.: signature; semester II.: basic language exam)
 - failure to attend classes: lost monthly stipend till the end of studies; failed exam: reduced stipend to HUF 30.000 up until successful exam
- ➤ Credit minimum requirement (to earn a total of **36 credits** by the end of each academic year) failure: termination of scholarship status

The above regulations DO NOT APPLY to PhD students!



FAQ: Is it possible to change...





... my study programme / institution / language of instruction?

- ✓ ONLY at the end of the 1st semester (deadline: 1 December 2024)
- ✓ OR at the end of the 1st academic year (deadline: 15 May 2025)
- To submit a request (a separate letter on an A4 sheet signed by you) to Tempus Public Foundation (stipendiumhungaricum@tpf.hu) attaching the following documents:
- an approval letter signed by the head of your current institute
- an **acceptance letter** from the head of the new study programme / institution (in case you want to change only the language of instruction, there is no need for this)
- a **support letter** from the **sending partner (authority)** in your home country
