

Subject registration in new student web


Enter your Neptun profile.

4.-5. Select filter: Recommended term ascending. With this filter you can arrange subjects accordingly to the curricular order, first semester subjects come ahead.



6.-11. By clicking on the v you can see the courses under the subject.



7-8 Select the appropriate course fit to your major curricula. Put checkmark in the boxes and 9. Click on the Take subject button


Meaning of course code tags: always seek for EN tags on English language first

EXAM ONLY (GOD): exam only for English program senior students in upper years, who took the class in earlier semester and already have the semester end signature, this course has no attendance just exam at the end of term

GOD-N-EN-MMUM1=PR01: GOD= Gödöllő Campus, N= full time, EN= English instruction, MMUM1= variable for training programmes, this is for Engineering management, PR01: practical course, EL00: theoretical course

If a subject has practical, theoretical, laboratory and field excoursion courses as well, you have to take all the courses to fulfill successful registration


If it has only 2 types or one type, than that is enough to take.

10. Please confirm your choice.


Then you can see the courses in the Calendar.



- 10. If first you wish to check the planned subjects in the calendar, you shall add courses to the planner by settling the slidebar to yellow stage

Be aware to add all courses to be able to ensure no overlapping between courses.

But please note, that adding to planner is not equivalent to subject registration. For registration, you need to hit the blue Take subject button (previous slide)
