Fundamental Obligations





Bear in mind (ORs - Section III.2-3.):





Signing SH agreement (after enrollment!) and registering in person – essential for receiving your monthly stipend (1st transfer in October!)

f TASK in DreamApply: **'Scholarship Agreement' to be uploaded**



Mandatory medical examination after your arrival in Hungary Tempus will provide further information on "when" to start it





Reporting obligation: SURVEY to fill in at the end of each academic year (link from Tempus in June via EMAIL - check!)

! Failing to do so, your monthly stipend might be suspended for one academic year.

Study-related Obligations





For full-time BSc and MSc students in English programmes: to attend and complete Hungarian as a Foreign Language and Culture (SH) I-II. = MID

(semester I.: signature; semester II.: basic language exam)

- missed classes: suspended monthly stipend till the end of studies;
- failed exam: reduced stipend to HUF 30.000 until passed exam
- Credit minimum requirement: to earn 36 credits / academic year)
 - failure: termination of scholarship status

The above regulations DO NOT APPLY to PhD students!



Staying in Hungary vs. abroad





Basic principle: scholarship holders are obliged to stay in Hungary during the academic year (incl. exam period)

LEAVING Hungary during academic year:

- For less than 10 days: no request needed, but notify your educational coordinator, once/semester
- For 10-30 days: request in Neptun, once/semester, eligible for stipend (both private and study-related purpose)
- For more than 30 days:
 - **Private purpose**: vis maior cases, once/semester, request in Neptun, no stipend & accommodation allowance, **passive** status
 - **Study-related purpose**: once/semester, request in Neptun, no stipend & accommodation allowance, **active** status
- PhD: max. 1 semester /study cycle (2x2 years) for research purpose, eligible for monthly stipend & accommodation allowance

FAQ: Can I change...





... my study programme / institution / language of instruction?

- ✓ ONLY at the end of the 1st semester (deadline: 1 December 2025)
- ✓ OR at the end of the 1st academic year (deadline: 15 May 2026)
- To submit a request (a separate letter on an A4 sheet signed by you) to Tempus Public Foundation (stipendiumhungaricum@tpf.hu) attaching the following documents:
- an approval letter signed by the head of your current institute
- an **acceptance letter** from the head of the new study programme / institution (in case you want to change only the language of instruction, there is no need for this)
- a **support letter** from the **sending partner (authority)** in your home country
